



Music City Center Sustainability Report Fiscal Year 2018-2019



Food & Beverage

Proud sponsor of community action and dialogue on reducing food waste through the state program **Get Food Smart TN**, the local **Nashville Food Waste Initiative**, and the **Mayor's Food Saver Challenge**.

Donated **40,395 lbs** of leftover food to the Nashville Rescue Mission.

Diverted food waste from the landfill by composting **131,162 lbs**.

Energy Use

Produced **248,681 kWh** of energy from our 845 solar panels on the roof above the Grand Ballroom. This saved us **\$24,520!**

Water Reuse

Collected **3,551,504 gallons** of rain water from the Green Roof. The water is stored in an underground 360,000 gallon cistern, and is then pumped throughout the building when needed. This reduced our municipal water usage by **51%**!

Community Connection

Hosted **23** free sustainability tours of the building to nonprofits, schools, and professionals.

Supported local nonprofits through silent auction donations and sponsorships.

Member of the **Corporate Sustainability Roundtable** to learn and discuss best sustainability practices with other Nashville businesses.

Donated in-kind over **13,800 lbs** of leftover items to **23** different nonprofit partners!

Recycling
